Guidelines:

- All designs must contain *school appropriate* content
- Designs must be drawn on this form and turned into Ms. Serpa (2230) or Ms. Stang (2205) for approval by Friday, August 12, 2022 at 2pm.
- If your design is not approved, you will receive an email to your school r2.d2@pcsb.org email account with details.
- ONLY Interior Latex Paint may be used on the parking surface
- Students may need to paint over a painting from the previous year. Make sure you bring enough paint!
- No paint 6 inches from the white lines and 12 inches from the number
- Your design must be able to be painted in the 4 hour window

Suggestions:

- Make a copy or take a photo of your design
- Bring a broom (to clean your surface), chalk and painters tape to help layout your design, yard stick, water for cleaning brushes, paint (remember this is not a smooth surface and may take more paint than a flat wall)
- Hydration (water, sport drink, etc...) There is little shade in the parking lot!
